

Tropical Storm Ida

Location: The Gulf of Mexico

Impact: Property, offshore, energy and marine exposure

Summary:

The hurricane season gradually intensifies, with the 9th named storm of the season Ida, currently in the Caribbean and heading towards Louisiana, USA.

16 years ago, Hurricane Katrina made devastating landfall in Louisiana and produced historic losses. NHC forecasts Ida to impact the same area on Sunday PM, with 115 MPH winds, corresponding to category 3 hurricane strength.




Figure 1 - trajectory of Ida on 27 Aug 2021








Figure 2 – Mobile Drilling, TLP's and other offshore assets in the path of Ida on 27 Aug 2021


OFFSHORE ENERGY
